Arundel State School Uniform Policy - 2020

(Reviewed and approved by P&C, 2019)

The official school colours of Arundel State School are teal, white and navy blue. The reflects these official school colours.

The Arundel State School Uniform Requirements

TASS uniform comprises a range of items for summer and winter wear. This range includes:

- School polo shirt with emblem (day and sport design)
- School shorts
- School skorts
- School dress
- School hat with house colours
- White socks
- Black/navy stockings (no leggings)
- School tracksuit pants
- School tracksuit jacket
- Plain coloured t-shirt for sport carnivals (as per house colour)
- Shoes- Solid black (no coloured trims), fully enclosed (Workplace Health and Safety Regulations require all students to wear footwear with substantial uppers; i.e., not sandals, thongs, canvas slip-ons etc)

All of these items (excluding shoes, stockings and socks) may be conveniently purchased through the school uniform shop. The Uniform Shop accepts cash/cheque or EFTPOS payments. (Second hand items are also available)

Restrictions on items allowed at school

TASS uniform policy places certain restrictions on what may be worn at school:

- Jeans are not an acceptable part of the school uniform at any time
- Jewellery is to be restricted to any/all of the following: a watch, two pairs of sleepers/studs for pierced ears, and any medical bracelets
- Make-up and nail polish are not appropriate for use at school

The uniform requirement at school-based events outside school

TASS uniform policy requires students to wear an appropriate uniform at school-based events outside the school. As a guideline, this would include:

- For excursions, at least the normal 'core' uniform worn at school
- For more formal activities, a full school uniform, with any variations to be decided by the Principal or Deputy Principal
- For choir and band performances band & choir uniform

Loan Uniforms

Loan uniforms are available for students whose uniforms become unwearable during the day as well as to those who do not comply with the uniform requirements.

Administration of the policy

There will be a two-week period of grace at the beginning of the school year to allow for any late purchase of uniforms. Students who are out of school uniform for any legitimate reason should bring a note to the office. Students will receive a uniform "exemption" green slip. If students are frequently out of uniform, a note will be sent home advising parents of the school policy.

ARUNDEL STATE SCHOOL HAIR POLICY

Hair longer than shoulder length is to be tied up with a band. Any hair accessories are to be in school colours, small enough to fit under a hat, and not flamboyant in nature (eg. Jojo bows are not appropriate). Mohawk styles, shaved tracks and undercuts are not acceptable. Colouring of hair is to be of natural tones.
